BEACH RE-PROFILING 16 – 17 MAY 2024
with
BEACH CLOSURES
THURSDAY 1400 – 1800 (From Ferry Shelter to Marine Parade Steps)
FRIDAY 0800 – 1700 (The Whole Beach)



The aim of the one and half days is to build up the beach in front of Marine Parade by the steps which has disappeared over the winter period due to the storms. This will involve using heavy machinery to move sand and rocks. As a result of the works being undertaken the beach will be closed for the above periods for health and safety reasons.

Boats who hold permit numbers 1-73 will have to be moved down the beach so that sand can be taken from that part of the beach to the area in front of Marine Parade. If your boat has one of the above numbers please can you make sure that boat is not locked to the posts otherwise the Parish Council may have to use a bolt cutter to remove it.

If there are any volunteers that wish to help on the day please can you contact clerk@shaldonparishcouncil.gov.uk or any of the Parish Councillors.

The Parish Council will do everything it can to do the work as quickly as possible so that the beach can be opened for those who wish to use it.

For those wishing to catch the Ferry to Teignmouth they will be asked to wait in the Ferry Shelter until the Ferry has come up on to the beach when safe passage across the beach will be made.
