



## SHALDON PARISH COUNCIL GRANT AWARD POLICY

Shaldon Parish Council is pleased to announce that it has statutory powers to make funds available to local organisations for the overall benefit of Shaldon and its residents. The grant award policy is designed to provide support to local not-for-profit groups, charitable or volunteer organisations or worthy causes delivering services to the community of Shaldon. A grant is any payment made by the Parish Council to an organisation for a specific purpose that will benefit the Parish, or residents of the Parish and which is not directly controlled or administered by the Parish Council. The size of any grant awarded is at the discretion of the Parish Council.

Grant applications will only be considered if the application form is completed and obtained from the Parish Clerk at [clerk@shaldonparishcouncil.gov.uk](mailto:clerk@shaldonparishcouncil.gov.uk)

The following organisations are eligible to apply:

- a. Shaldon based charities, clubs, associations, groups or other organisations whose activities benefit all or some of the Shaldon community.
- b. Local branches of regional or national charities, clubs, associations, groups or other organisations whose activities benefit all or some of the Shaldon community.

Applications are considered at Full Council meetings in November and May.

The deadline for November applications is 22 November.
